Acceptance of terms

Kitchen respects its users' privacy. We put this Privacy Policy together to show how we collect, use and protect your personal information. By using the Kitchen you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy shall be governed in accordance to international treaty provisions and other applicable laws.

Changes in privacy policy

We have the right to update this Privacy Policy at any time. It is your responsibility to keep yourself informed with the latest edition of the Kitchen's Privacy Policy.

Collection of personal information

To be able to provide our services and share news and updates about these same services with you, we collect some personal information for you, like your name, company name and email address.

To be able to complete your purchase order and bill you for subscription, we may collect some billing information, like your credit card number, expiration date, security code and billing address.

As most modern websites do to provide a better user experience for their clients we also collect some technical information for you (using "cookies" and your log data), like your browser type, operating system, IP address or geographical location.

Accessing your personal information

You have the right to review the information we store for you and make any changes you wish. You can do this from your account settings.

How your personal information is used

Kitchen collects and uses your personal information to:

- administer your account;
- provide customer service;
- process your financial transactions;
- share news about upcoming services;
- conduct marketing research and analysis;
- monitor user behaviour;

We may send you marketing emails to inform you about the launch of new products or services that may be of your interest. It is possible that some of these emails come from other businesses within 2 Create Ltd. You can unsubscribe from these emails at any point, emailing us at the unsubscribe email address placed at the bottom of the messages. However, system and transactional messages, like purchase and billing confirmations, will still be sent to you.

Data retention

We will retain your personal information with us, as long as your account is active.

Protection of your personal information

The security of your personal information is important for us and we protect it in several ways:

- your account password is encrypted;
- your personal information is encrypted when passed to us;
- your personal information is stored on a secured server;
- the information you enter on your registration or payment form is SSL encrypted;
- our employees have limited access to your personal information;
- all our employees sign confidentiality agreements;

Additional rights for eu citizens
